Subject: Report of Day 6 (22.9.2025) on celebration SHS 2025 by ICAR-IIWM,
Bhubaneswar - reg

Considering the critical importance of social security and welfare schemes of central government for the poor on one hand and their lack of awareness about such schemes on the other, a workshop on 'linking poor to Government Welfare Schemes' was organized on the Day-6 of SHS 2025 programme (i.e. 22.9.2025) with support from State Bank of India (SBI). A team of officers led by Shri Dillip Kumar Nayak, Chief Manager (Value Added) were the resource persons in the workshop. At the beginning, the Senior most principal Scientist & Programme Leader Dr. R.K. Panda welcomed guest experts, and this was followed by a brief introduction by the Chairman of the Swachhta Committee on the theme of the workshop and its importance for contractual and other categories of working population. Shri Dillip Kumar Nayak made a presentation on central govt. social security schemes in which he discussed different insurance and pension schemes, eligibility criteria, maturity period, premium involved, benefits to insurer and family under different situations. He also answered the queries of the participants and cleared their doubts. Shri Suvendu Pati, Area Manager (SBI Life) discussed some of the low premium high insurance coverage products and their benefits for wage earning and other classes of employees. In the last part of the workshop, the participants had the opportunity to discuss their problems relating to the policies they have had and evinced interest in some of the schemes for securing their families. SBI officials also pledged full support to the persons interested to avail government and other schemes. Others who shared their knowledge on the subject were Shri Salil Palei (Wealth Manager) and Mrs. Trinita Pradhan, branch manager, SBI, Rail Vihar branch.

Earlier, SBI officers had a discussion with the Director of the institute Dr Arjamadutta Sarangi on provisions of various schemes and products of SBI life affordable to sanitary and other workers and the modalities to link them to such schemes.
